

SUMMARY

This report provides the results of a demonstration and assessment of selected United States Air Force (USAF) medical technologies during the Pacific Warrior 2001 (PW 01) exercise, which was held on the island of Oahu, Hawaii (HI), during the period 28 January through 9 February 2001. A more comprehensive description of the assessment results for each of the technologies is contained in the appropriate annexes of this report.
